- **60+** billion events per day
- **129,395** detected incidents, resulting in **25,076** confirmed security incidents
- Hacking Companies of all sizes faced attacks, with malware representing **30%** of incidents.
- Large enterprises (**40%**) are impacted the most by Cyber Extortion, followed by small organizations (**25%**) and medium-sized businesses (**23%**).
- The Manufacturing sector (**32.43%**) is the largest contributor in terms of confirmed incidents, Retail Trade (**21.73%**) and Professional, Scientific and Technological Services (**9.84%**) completed the top three.
- **37.45%** of detected incidents originate from internal actors, whether deliberate or accidental.
- New research finds a new levelling of physical and cyber battlefields, revealing a thin line between physical war and cyber (through hacktivism)
- Europe was impacted by **85%** of all hacktivist attacks seen in 2023, followed by North America (**7%**) and the Middle East (**3%**).
- **109 CVEs** (Common Vulnerabilities and Exposures = public information about published security vulnerabilities) in 2023.
